

## Points of Interest    Rineen/Ceim Hill

**26. Ancient ring fort:** On the left side of the road, surrounded by trees. Not accessible to public.

**27. Rineen Woods:** An Coilte national park, with walking trails and a picnic area. An old Lime Kiln can be seen on the trail beside the water. When leaving the park look out for the beautiful Beal a'chinn mora bridge.

**28. Fairy houses:** Specially for children, look out for some fairy houses near the start of the main track.

**29. View point:** Views to the right, down to the old Rineen Mill, and out over Castlehaven estuary, Horse Island, and the Stag rocks.

**30. View point:** Views down over the Narrows, and Castletownsend village.

**20. Lough Cluhir :** Local legend says that every seven years a three masted ship can be seen on the lake, but bad luck falls to those who see it.

**21. Old National School:** Former national school, opened in 1885 with separate boys and girls schools.
